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1.0 Introduction

The effectiveness of the Academy's careers provision is measured in the following ways:

- Internal surveys.

2.0 Destination Data

Refer to [Destination Data Report](#). For the recently updated DfE performance tables (October 2018), the % of pupils in education, employment and training was 97% vs. a NA of 94% (+3%).

3.0 Internal Surveys

The following data relates to a questionnaire completed by pupils at the end of Year 10 in respect to specific areas of their careers provision.

With the exception of apprenticeships, the vast majority of pupils (>85%) recorded a positive or neutral response.
