Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE) is a subject through which pupils develop the knowledge, skills and attributes they need to keep themselves healthy and safe, and prepared for life and work. Further, the Relationships and Sex and Health Education (RSHE) aspects will be compulsory from September 2020 in accordance with the updated statutory guidance.

Schools are required to consult parents in developing and reviewing their PSHE and RSHE policy. In preparation, I have attached a draft Trust policy which covers the primary and secondary phases.
