FINAL REVISION PROGRAMME BEGINS	Easter holiday onwards	Year 11 Revision Parents' Evening (2) – 20 February 2017.



92% of pupils with an attendance of 96% and above achieved at least 5 A-C's including English and Maths. (less than 4 days absence).

81% of pupils in the Academy achieved at least 5 A-C's including English and Maths.

Only 20% of pupils with an attendance of 90% and below achieved at least 5 A-C's including English and Maths. (There are 22 pupils in this category at present).

Year 8 = 95.9 %

Year 11 = 95.6%
