# GCSE Results Report 2023 Cohort 

Eästwood

Believe, Succeed, Together

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### 1.0 Synopsis

The 2023 cohort were the second group to undertake external GCSE examinations since 2019, although an adjustment in assessment content and examination support were provided for the 2022 cohort.

For the 2020 and 2021 cohorts, GCSE grades were awarded using Teacher Assessed Grades (TAG), but (nationally) the grades were inflated when compared to 2019 levels. In order to 'remove' the inflation and bring grades back in line with 2019 levels, the DfE directed Ofqual to adjust grade boundaries accordingly. This is detailed in Examination Results - JCQ Joint Council for Qualifications where the range of decrease from 2022 is between $5-10 \%$ (depending on the subject).

For the purposes of this report, although a comparison with the 2019 cohort is certainly more meaningful, the following should be noted:

- The 2023 cohort experienced significant educational disruption as a result of the Government's response to the Covid-19 pandemic.
- The level of persistent absence for the 2023 cohort was $26.0 \%$. Whilst this was below the national average for this year group ( $30.0 \%$ ), it was significantly higher than the 2019 cohort (10.6\%).

In terms of the performance of the 2023 cohort, the following can be summarised:

- All KPI measures were significantly above the national average (NA).
- The majority of pupil groups recorded a positive P8.
- Approximately $70 \%$ of subjects performed above expectations.
- The \% of top grades in 2019 and 2023 are broadly aligned.

In 2023, the majority of pupil groups recorded a positive P8 i.e. performed above expectations.
*This pupil group comprised of three pupils. Two pupils achieved a P8 of +1.00 and one achieved a P8 of -5.00 i.e. the overall P8 is skewed by one pupil.
