Your child will be issued with a hard copy of their GCSE Predicted Grades on **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> November**. The reason for the early release of these grades is to coincide with requests from 6<sup>th</sup> Form and Further Education colleges.

At this stage, the Academy intends to press ahead with its mock examination timetable which commences on **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> December**. Pupils will receive further details in the forthcoming days.

Using the mock examination performance, along with continuous classroom assessment, your child will be issued with an Achievement Report and updated Predicted Grades on **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January**.

As I am sure you are aware, there has been recent coverage in the press regarding the GCSE arrangements for pupils in Wales, specifically, that external examinations will not be going ahead this summer. My understanding, at this stage, is that in England, examinations will still go ahead as planned.
